## ***Ownership of Church Pews***

Below is an Account who this Row of closets Belong too Next  
The North door this 11<sup>th</sup> day of November 1736

John Cooke or John Carter three seats between them which seats  
was sold two to John Crowther & one to John Brooke: John Brooke  
sold his one to Abraham Meller & John Crowthers widow sold her  
Two to David Street January the 12<sup>th</sup> 1771 David Street sold  
his two to Joseph Schofield witness Rich Lodge Clark  
Edward Brooke & William Hobson the other three between them(?)  
Now in the possession of John Brook and Richard Beaumont

Joseph Dyson two seats sold to John & Thomas Horsfield  
Sept 14 1737 Thos Horsfield sold his seat to John Mallinson witness my hand  
Thomas Horsfall

Mr Richard Langley one seat past over to John Brooke & sold to  
Rebecca Graham. & Ellis Morton one seat &  
passed over Joseph Brooke of Mirfield 1718  
John Turner 2 seats & Nov ye 6<sup>th</sup> sold them to  
John Hall as witness my hand John Turner

Richard North 2 seats – Jonathan Howarth in north  
Gallery (?) over ..... Langley 1739

John Crowther two seats sold by his widow to George Dyson  
Mr Townley two seats  
Mr Layburn one Arthue Blackburn one – both sold to John Spivey

Sir John Kaye four seats past over to Mr Thos Dickin  
In the year 1671 now in the possession of Mr Francis Watts  
Mr Townley two seats

Robert Lyley 6 seats now Francis Lyleys

Christopher Brooke 4 seats but in the year 1670 he sold  
two to Ralph Barlowe and the other 2 was sold since to John Horsfield  
Arthur Blackburn 2 seats but in the year 1672 James  
Middleton sold them to John Horsfield now the 4 blong to Thomas Horsfield

Samuell Jepson 6 seats now Josiah Stocks

Richard Thewlis 2 seats John Cowper 2 seats and Joseph Walton 2 seats

Mr John Townley 6 seats which by Tenant Right belonge
